FIRST CALL FOR PAPERS

The Argentine Congress on Computer Sciences (CACIC), of the Computer Science National Universities Network (RedUNCI), has become the most important academic event on computer sciences of Argentina, gathering the contributions of many teachers, researchers, undergraduate and graduate students, as well as computer technology professionals from the country and abroad.

CACIC 2004 will be held from 4th to 8th October, 2004, in the City of San Justo, District of La Matanza, Buenos Aires, Argentina, organized by the National University of La Matanza (Universidad Nacional de La Matanza).

This is the first call for papers for CACIC 2004 and for School courses presentations.

The submitted papers should be original, related to relevant subjects on research and computer applications, neither published nor submitted to publication elsewhere in versions substantially the same.

The articles will be evaluated according to criteria on originality, clarity and contribution to the Computer Science's fields. The selected papers – whose authors commit their attendance to the event – will be published in the Congress proceedings and, according to the judges' opinion, will be proposed for their publication in the Journal of Computer Science & Technology edited internationally

The reviewing process is undertaken by international reviewers, which will be listed in InterNet before the selection begins.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR WORKS PRESENTATION

The preferred format for electronic submission is PDF or PostScript, via the Congress Web page, or e-mail or regular mail, to the indicated addresses. The procedure is described in detail in the Web page. A reference number will be send to each author, which should be used in all inquiries regarding paper acceptance.

The submission of papers should follow these requirements:

- Written in English, Spanish or Portuguese.
- In size paper A4 (21cm x 29,7 cm).
- Should not exceed 12 pages, including references, figures, tables, etc.
- The abstract should be no more than 200 words long.
- Margin specifications: upper 3,5 cm; lower, right and left: 2 cm.
- Format specifications: justified text, with not numbered pages. Times 12 Font for text and Times 14 Font for headings and paragraphs. First page should contain: title of the paper, name and affiliation of all the authors, their addresses, as well as the abstract, a list of keywords for classification (referred to the chosen topic), and if it is sent for a specific Workshop.
